WORMS

- THEY LIVE ATTACHED TO ROCKS IN THE SEA.

ARTHROPODS



- THEY HAVE GOT LONG, SOFT BODIES.
- THEY HAVEN'T GOT LEGS.
- THEY LIVE ON LAND AND IN WATER.



ECHINODERMS



MOLLUSCS

- THE BIGGEST GROUP OF INVERTEBRATES.
- THEY LIVE ON LAND OR IN WATER.
- THEY HAVE GOT ANTENNAE, ARTICULATED LEGS AND AN EXOSKELETON.

- THEY HAVE GOT SOFT BODIES.
- MANY OF THEM HAVE GOT A SHELL AND LIVE IN THE SEA. OTHERS LIVE ON LAND.

- THEY HAVE GOT SPINES.
- THEY LIVE IN THE OCEAN AND SOME USE THEIR SMALL FEET TO MOVE ON THE OCEAN FLOOR.
