

PAST TENSE - LEARNING THE VERBS

1. Read

We use the **past** to talk about things we did in the past.
(*Usamos el pasado simple para hablar de cosas que hicimos en el pasado*)

In english, we have two types of verbs (*En inglés, tenemos dos tipos de verbos*):

- Regular verbs: turn them to past by adding -ed. (*Los convertimos a pasado añadiendo -ed al final*).
For example: *lik**ed**, play**ed**, start**ed**, cook**ed**...*
- Irregular verbs: the form of the verb changes (*La forma del verbo cambia*) For example:

TRANSLATION	PRESENT	PAST
Comprar	Buy	Bought
Traer	Bring	Brought
Venir	Come	Came
Elegir	Choose	Chose
Conducir	Drive	Drove
Alimentar	Feed	Fed
Encontrar	Find	Found
Dar	Give	Gave
Esconder	Hide	hid
Perder	Lose	Lost
montar	Ride	Rode
Sentarse	Sit	Sat
Ver	See	Saw
Dormir	Sleep	Slept

Levantarse	Stand	Stood
Contar	Tell	Told
Tomar	Take	Took
Llevar puesto	Wear	Wore

For the negative, we don't change the main verb. We use **didn't** instead. (Para la forma negativa, no cambiamos el verbo principal. En lugar de ello, utilizamos didn't). For example:

*I **didn't** give my sister chocolate- No le di a mi hermana chocolate*

*I **gave** my sister chocolate- Le di a mi hermana chocolate*
