



Let's Recap: Un auxiliaire est un mot qui nous dit à quel temps nous sommes. Avec l'auxiliaire, le verbe ne se conjugue pas.

Present simple: auxiliary **do/does**. "**s**" à la troisième personne du singulier.

je l'utilise pour parler des habitudes, la routine, ce que j'aime et ce que je n'aime pas.

ex: Pusheen **eats** pizza on Saturdays. Pusheen **does not** eat pizza on Saturdays. **Does** pusheen eat pizza on Saturdays?

Use the present simple.

She (sing) very well. Alexis (not have) a girlfriend. Tyron (walk) to school everyday.

Théo (work) on his strike Fridays? Noémie and Noémy (not dance) zouk during the presentation. Enzo (rap) in secret ? they (speak) German?



Be, comme Beyoncé, ce verbe n'a pas besoin d'auxiliaire (d'aide)

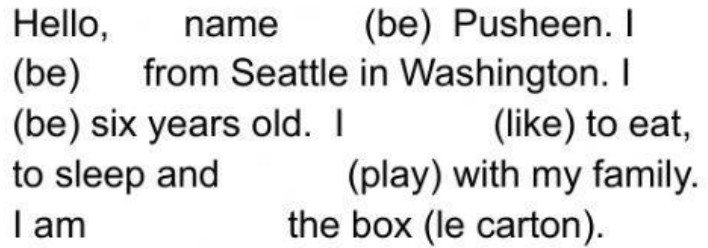
Present: **am, are, is**

ex:

Beyoncé **is** talented. **Is** Beyoncé talented? Beyoncé **is not** very tall.

Use "be" past simple and present simple.

Allan (not be) tired today. Usually, Kevan (not be) naughty. Swann (be) often funny. Alicia here today? Dadju (be) Harold's favourite rapper? Soyenne and Maëlle (be) the cupcake specialists. it mine (be)? They (be) never hungry last week. Mayra and Mahlia (be) always happy.

Pusheen and Pip. The moon is the house. Sloth sleeps
 Fluffy. The chimney is the roof.
