

# The earth – from clay to brick







Look at these pictures and tell your friend what is happening in each one.




Clay is being dug up.



A machine is cutting up the clay mixture into strips.




Clay is ground up finely and mixed with water.




A different machine is used to cut the strips into blocks.



The blocks of clay are dried.  
The dried pieces of clay are baked in a huge oven, called a kiln.



When the bricks are removed from the kiln, they are sorted.



The bricks are put on top of one another in piles and are ready to be sold.
