7:45 - It's seven forty-five. - It's fifteen to eight. It's quarter to eight.	7:55 It's seven fifty-five. It's five to eight.		

We use AT + TIME when giving the time of a specific event.

- The class starts at nine o'clock.
- The flight leaves at ten to three.

We use IT IS or IT'S to answer a question that asks for the time right now.

What time is it? - It is half past four.
 What's the time? - It's twenty to five.
