

A brief info about Halloween:



Halloween is a celebration that happens on 31st of October. The 1st of November, is All Saint Day, so Halloween is the night before.

The holiday is always celebrated in America, but its origin is in Ireland.

The Irish people, believed that bad spirits would come to hunt them. They started dressing in costumes to scare these bad spirits.

There are three traditions for Halloween in America.

- The first is craving a pumpkin with a scary face. Then, they put a candle inside the pumpkin. These pumpkins with a face are named Jack-o'-lantern.
- The second is decorating your house. People decorate their home as a haunted house. They use skeletons, skulls, tombs, jack-o'-lanterns...
- The third is going trick-or-treat. Children usually dress up with a costume and ask around the neighbourhood for candies and chocolates.
