ADVERBS

We usually use adverbs of frequency with the present simple, but **they can also be used with the present continuous**. The adverb comes between the auxiliary and the main verb.

- **The simple present** is the tense you use for any habitual action. Use it for things that you always do, are regular or true.

Example: I clean my room every day.

ALWAYS 100%	I always do my homework.
USUALLY 90%	You usually listen to music.
OFTEN 75%	She often plays rugby on Friday.
SOMETIMES 50%	He sometimes goes to the gym.
NEVER 0%	They never eat chocolate.
