50%	SOMETIMES	We <i>sometimes</i> order pizza for dinner.
10%	HARDLY EVER RARELY	She <i>hardly ever</i> smiles.
0%	NEVER	They are <i>never</i> at home when we call.

POSITIVE	SUBJECT	FREQUENCY ADVERB	VERB	He <i>often</i> cooks pasta.
QUESTION	AUXILIARY	SUBJECT	FREQUENCY ADVERB	Are you <i>always</i> late? Does he <i>often</i> cook?

⚠ Use NEVER and HARDLY EVER with positive verbs

✘ He isn't never late.	✘ They don't hardly ever go to the library.
✔ He is never late.	✔ They hardly ever go to the library.
