VERBO HAVE TO (TENER QUE)

-Ejemplo: + *I have to go*: Yo tengo que ir

- *I don't have to go*: Yo no tengo que ir

¿ *Do you have to go*? ¿Tú tienes que ir?

WHOSE _____ IS IT?

- **Whose is it?** Significa en español: ¿De quién es eso? Y se utiliza para preguntar la posesión de un objeto.
- Para contestarlo se utiliza la estructura **It's** + el nombre de la persona terminado en 's



- También podemos preguntar por algo específico del objeto de una persona. Por ejemplo:

Is Noura's hat white? (¿Es el sombrero de Noura blanco?) y lo contestamos: **Yes, it is.**

Is Noura's hat black? (¿Es el sombrero de Noura negro?) y lo contestamos: **No it, isn't**
