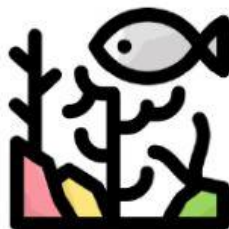

LANDFORMS VOCABULARY

Drag the landform to its corresponding definition

a natural wide flow of fresh water
across the land into the sea, or a lake.

city

the salty water that covers a large
part of the surface of the earth, or a
large area of salty water, smaller than
an ocean, that is partly or completely
surrounded by land

town

a place where many people live, with
many houses, stores, businesses, etc.,
and which is bigger than a town

river

a place where people live and work,
containing many houses, shops,
places of work, places of
entertainment, etc., and usually
smaller than a city

sea

LANDFORMS VOCABULARY

Drag the landform to its corresponding definition

a field of grass, often with flowers



Coral reef

a large area of water surrounded by land and not connected to the ocean except by rivers or streams



cave

an area of coral, the top of which can sometimes be seen just above the sea



meadow

a large hole in the ground or in the side of a mountain



lake

LANDFORMS VOCABULARY

Drag the landform to its corresponding definition

an area of sand or small stones near the ocean or another area of water such as a lake

forest

a deep valley between high steep banks, usually containing a river

beach

an area, often covered with sand or rocks, where there is very little rain and not many plants

canyon

a large area of land covered with trees and plants, usually larger than a wood, or the trees and plants themselves

desert

LANDFORMS VOCABULARY

Drag the landform to its corresponding definition

a high area of land that is smaller than a mountain

hill

a piece of land completely surrounded by water

mountain

a raised part of the earth's surface, much larger than a hill, the top of which might be covered in snow

ocean

a very large area of sea.
the large mass of salt water that covers most of the earth's surface

island

LANDFORMS VOCABULARY

Drag the landform to its corresponding definition

a mountain with a large, circular hole at the top through which lava (= hot liquid rock) gases, steam, and dust are or have been forced out

oasis

a place in the desert where there is water and where plants grow

volcano

a curved shape with colors that sometimes appears in the sky when the sun shines through rain

waterfall

water, especially from a river or stream, dropping from a higher to a lower point, sometimes from a great height

rainbow
