What is **the biggest** desert in the world?

The Sahara is **the biggest** desert in the world.

Which city is **the most beautiful**: Venice, Florence, or Rome?

I think Venice is **the most beautiful** city!

NOTE: good → better → **the best**
bad → worse → **the worst**
