PRESENT SIMPLE AFFIRMATIVE, NEGATIVE


- **AFFIRMATIVE**

SUBJECT + VERB.

- **NEGATIVE: REMEMBER TO USE THE AUXILIARIES:**

DO / DOES + INFINITIVE VERB

SUBJECT +	AUXILIARY +	NOT +	INFINITIVE VERB.
I / YOU / WE / THEY	DO		
HE / SHE / IT	DOES		

CHECK THE FOLLOWING EXAMPLES:

- 1) Anna goes trekking every Saturday.
Anna doesn't go trekking every Saturday.
- 2) I have lunch in the cafeteria on Friday.
I don't have lunch in the cafeteria on Friday.
