

IRREGULAR VERBS

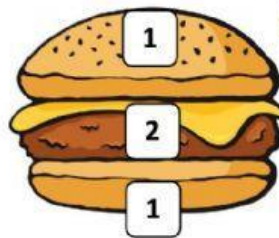
Group 1: The verb is the same in the infinitive, past simple and past participle forms. (1 – 1 – 1)



Infinitive (= Base Form)	Past Simple Form	Past Participle
bet	bet	bet
burst	burst	burst
cost	cost	cost
cut	cut	cut
hit	hit	hit
hurt	hurt	hurt
let	let	let
put	put	put
read	read pronounced /red/	read pronounced /red/
set	set	set
shut	shut	shut
spread	spread	spread

Group 2: **Same** infinitive and past participle forms, but **different** past simple form. (1 – 2 – 1)

Infinitive (= Base Form)	Past Simple Form	Past Participle
bec <u>o</u> me	bec <u>a</u> me	bec <u>o</u> me
c <u>o</u> me	c <u>a</u> me	c <u>o</u> me
r <u>u</u> n	r <u>a</u> n	r <u>u</u> n

sleep	slept	slept
sweep	swept	swept
smell	smelt (or smelled)	smelt (or smelled)
spell	spelt (or spelled)	spelt (or spelled)
spoil	spoilt (or spoiled)	spoilt (or spoiled)

Past form ends in -EW Past Participle ends in -OWN		
Infinitive	Past Simple Form	Past Participle
blow	blew	blown
grow	grew	grown
know	knew	known
throw	threw	thrown
fly	flew	flown

draw	drew	drawn
show	showed	shown

Past form ends in -ORE Past Participle ends in -ORN		
Infinitive	Past Simple Form	Past Participle
swear	swore	sworn
tear	tore	torn
wear	wore	worn



Past Participle ends in -EN

bite	bit	bitten
hide	hid	hidden
eat	ate	eaten
fall	fell	fallen
forget	forgot	forgotten
forgive	forgave	forgiven
give	gave	given
shake	shook	shaken
take	took	taken
break	broke	broken
choose	chose	chosen
freeze	froze	frozen
speak	spoke	spoken
steal	stole	stolen
