7 th seventh	17 th seventeenth	27 th twenty-seventh
8 th eighth	18 th eighteenth	28 th twenty-eighth

USES OF ORDINAL NUMBERS		
DATES: Her birthday is on the 29th .		
CENTURIES: Shakespeare was born in the 16th century.		
SEQUENCE/ORDER: My team came second in the league.		
FLOORS OF A BUILDING: His office is on the tenth floor.
