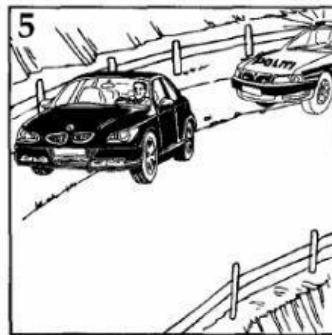
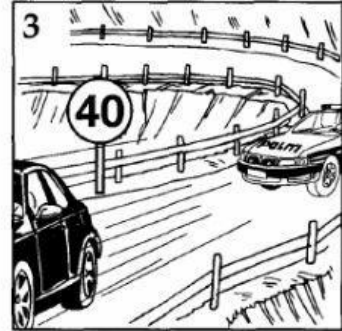
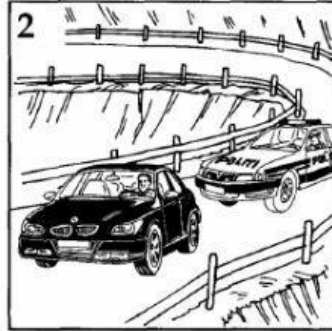


1. PRE-READING

The police officer doesn't give the man a ticket. Why not? The man in the black car was driving too fast, wasn't he? Yes, he was. But he is the king of Norway.

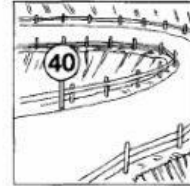
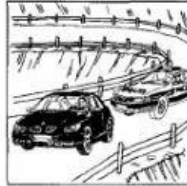

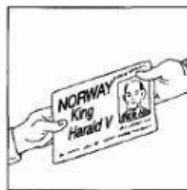
