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GLOBAL ENGLISH 7: UNIT 5 – THE GREAT OUTDOORS GRAMMAR 1

A. GRAMMAR

***Lưu ý:** Các từ vựng mở rộng thầy cô cho ghi trong vở (nếu có) và các từ vựng mở rộng trong phiếu để có chủ thích nghĩa: con về nhà chép mỗi từ 1 dòng để ghi nhớ nhé.

I – Expressing the future: Để diễn đạt những hành động sẽ xảy ra ở tương lai, ta có thể dùng các cách sau:

- **Hiện tại tiếp diễn (Be + V-ing):** diễn tả những dự định, sắp xếp đã lên lịch trong tương lai. Hoặc diễn đạt một sự việc xảy ra trong tương lai ở một thời điểm nhất định.

Ex: *I'm coming to see you in December.*

I'm playing golf with some friends at 8 a.m. tomorrow morning.

- **be going to + V-inf:** diễn tả những dự định có từ trước thời điểm nói. Dự đoán về những sự việc sẽ xảy ra dựa trên các dấu hiệu ở hiện tại.

Ex: *I'm going to sew (may) my own clothes. I've already bought some nice fabric (vải).*

Look at these dark clouds. It's going to rain.

Something smells good. Dinner is going to be delicious.

- **will/ shall + V-inf:** diễn tả về những thông tin, nhận định về tương lai nhưng không có căn cứ, những dự đoán và phỏng đoán những điều sẽ diễn ra, hoặc dùng để hứa hay đưa ra lời đề nghị lịch sự.

Ex: *I think you will have a great time.*

Shall we try to finish the project today?

- **Hiện tại đơn (S + V(s/es)):** diễn tả những sự việc sẽ diễn ra theo thời gian biểu, ví dụ: lịch tàu xe, lịch chiếu phim, lịch phát sóng các chương trình truyền hình. Hoặc dùng trong mệnh đề chỉ thời gian tương lai – *when*.

Ex: *The train leaves on the 21st of November.*

Hurry up! I don't want to miss any of the game. It starts at 1 p.m.

When I grow up, I will become an astronaut.

II – Superlative adjectives (So sánh nhất của tính từ)

- So sánh nhất với tính từ ngắn: S + V + the + adj ngắn + est (+ N)

Ex: *My dad is the greatest person in the world.*

***Lưu ý:**

- Những tính từ/ trạng từ ngắn có **1 âm tiết**, ta thêm đuôi **-est** vào sau dạng nguyên thể của chúng.

Ex: *cold => coldest*

- Những tính từ/ trạng từ có tận cùng là **e** thì chỉ thêm **-st**.

Ex: *cute => cutest*

- Những tính từ có **1 âm tiết**, kết thúc bằng **nguyên âm + phụ âm** thì nhân đôi phụ âm và thêm **-est**.

Ex: *hot => hottest, big => biggest*

- Những tính từ có **2 âm tiết** kết thúc bằng **phụ âm y** → ta **đổi y thành i** và thêm **-est**.

Ex: *lucky => luckiest, happy => happiest*

- Các tính từ **2 âm tiết** nhưng tận cùng là **-er, -le, -ow, -et, -y, ...** thì xem như là một tính từ ngắn.

Ex: *clever, simple, narrow, quiet, lucky, etc.*

- So sánh nhất với tính từ dài:

S + V + the + most + adj dài (+ N)

Ex: He is **the most handsome** (boy) in his class.

These shirts are **the most expensive** of all.

***Lưu ý:**

- Các tính từ đuôi **-ed** là các tính từ dài (*polluted, satisfied, surprised, etc.*)

- Khi muốn nhấn mạnh, chúng ta có thể thêm **"by far"** vào công thức so sánh nhất.

Ex: Jim is **the smartest by far**.
