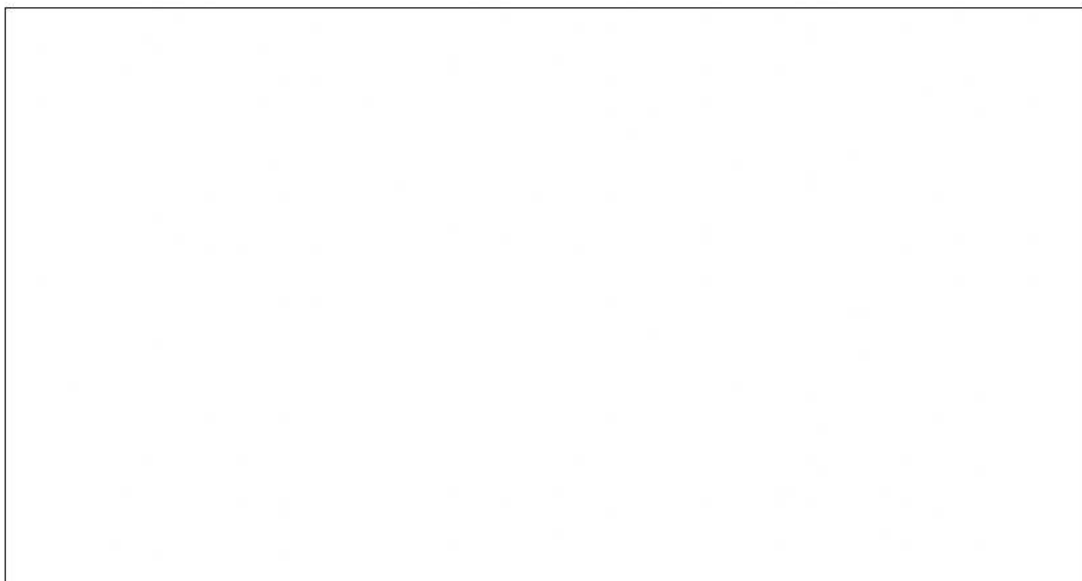

Step 2- Use the pencil to draw 3 garden plots with drainage			
Step 3- Use the molding clay to make 3 garden beds on the plots			
Step 4- Plant the wooden sticks 5 cm apart in the garden beds			
Step 5- Mold the sticks so that they are straight and don't fall over			
Step 6- Clean up the garden area and all tools used			
Step 7- Pack away all of the extra materials
