$$\frac{x}{5} = 2 \quad x =$$

$$\frac{2x}{3} = 8 \quad x =$$

$$\frac{x}{6} - \frac{3}{2} = -1 \quad x =$$

$$7 - \frac{3x}{5} = \frac{x}{10} \quad x =$$

$$3 + \frac{3x}{4} - \frac{7}{2} = -3 + x/8 \quad x =$$

$$\frac{x+6}{8} - 4x = 7 - \frac{3x}{4} \quad x =$$
