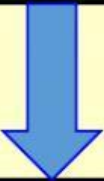
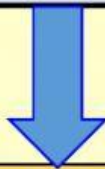


Regular Verbs

<u>Most verbs:</u> Add -ed	<u>Verb ends in -e:</u> Add only -d	<u>Verb ends in Consonant + Y:</u> Take off the Y + -ied	<u>Verb ends in C + V + C:</u> Double the last consonant + ed
<u>a</u> nswer - answer ed	arrive - arriv d	carry - carri ed	chat - chatt ed
ask - ask ed	complete - complet d	cry - cri ed	drop - dropp ed
call - call ed	dance - danc d	hurry - hurri ed	plan - plann ed
climb - clim ed	decide - decid d	study - studi ed	stop - stop ped
cook - cook ed	like - lik d	tidy - tidi ed	 This rule usually applies to short verbs (= with only 1 syllable).
enjoy - enjoy ed	live - liv d		
finish - finish ed		 Attention!!! If the verb ends in Vowel + Y, you just add -ed: play – played enjoy – enjoyed
