Grammar Rules Action Verbs

An **action verb** tells what a person, animal, or thing does.


Examples: *The boy runs.* *His parents talk.*

Add an **-s** to most action verbs to tell what one person, animal, or thing does.

Example: *Our dog chases squirrels.*

Do not add **-s** to tell what two or more people, animals, or things do.

Example: *The squirrels climb the tree.*
