Khẳng định	S + am/ is/ are + N/Adj. S + V(s/es) + O. Ex: <i>I am nineteen years old.</i> <i>She understands English.</i>	S + am/ is/ are + V-ing + O. Ex: <i>I am doing housework right now.</i>
Phủ định	S + am not / isn't / aren't + N/ Adj. S + don't / doesn't + V-infinitive. Ex: <i>I am not nineteen years old.</i> <i>She doesn't understand English.</i>	S + am not / isn't / aren't + V-ing. Ex: <i>I am not doing housework right now.</i> <i>It isn't raining now.</i>

Cách dùng	- Diễn tả 1 hành động xảy ra thường xuyên, lặp đi lặp lại theo quy luật, thói quen. Ex: <i>He learns English every day at 8 o'clock.</i>	- Diễn tả hành động đang xảy ra và kéo dài ở hiện tại. Ex: <i>I am doing my homework.</i>

Dấu hiệu nhận biết	Trong câu có các trạng từ chỉ tần suất như: - always (luôn luôn) - often (thường xuyên) - usually (thông thường) - sometimes (thỉnh thoảng) - every day/ week/ month (mỗi ngày/ tuần/ tháng), etc.	Trong câu có các trạng từ chỉ thời gian như: - now (hiện nay, ngay lúc này) - at present (hiện tại) - at the moment (tại thời điểm này), - right now (ngay bây giờ), v.v... - Đi kèm với các động từ có tính đề nghị, mệnh lệnh như: look, listen, be quiet, etc.
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II – Ing form as subjects, objects, and after a preposition

Danh động từ (gerund) là hình thức động từ được thêm “-ing” và được dùng như một danh từ.

Danh động từ có thể được dùng làm:

A, V-ing là chủ ngữ của câu (subject of a sentence):

- Khi đóng vai trò là chủ ngữ của câu, danh động từ được dùng như một danh từ:

Ex: *Jogging is my favorite sport.*

B, V-ing giữ vị trí tân ngữ của động từ (object of a verb):

- Danh động từ cũng được dùng như một **tân ngữ trực tiếp** sau một số động từ như: *admit, avoid, appreciate, dislike, enjoy, finish, keep, mention, mind, miss, postpone, risk, practice, etc.*

Ex: *I enjoy swimming in a deep pool.*

- Danh động từ cũng được dùng như một **tân ngữ trực tiếp** sau một số cụm từ: *can't bear, can't stand, can't help, can't resist, feel like, it's no use, it's (not) worth, there is no point in, etc.*

Ex: *I don't feel like talking to him after what he did to me.*

C, V-ing còn dùng sau giới từ (after a preposition):

Ex: *She's looking forward to seeing her boyfriend again.*
