We don't use too or either	* and + subject + auxiliary + too (for positive sentences) He enjoys outdoor activities , and his son does too . * and + subject + auxiliary + either (for negative sentences) We don't like going for walks in the heat , and he doesn't either .

*only statements with **and** are followed by **too** or **either**.
