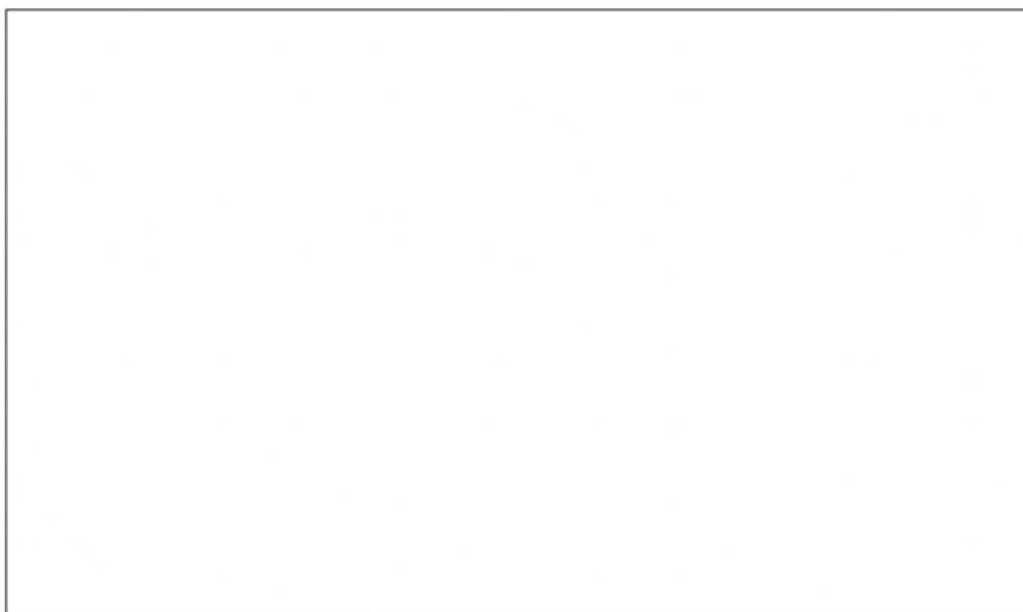

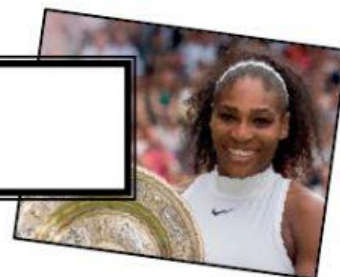
Serena Williams:
the USA's Greatest Sportsperson?

Serena Williams is the world's most successful women's tennis player and possibly the USA's greatest sportsperson ever. She has won more major tennis tournaments, or 'Grand Slams', than any other tennis player, and she's earned millions of dollars in prize money.

1 _____ She was born in Michigan in 1981 and is the youngest of five sisters. She started playing tennis when she was only five years old, and it became clear, even at that young age, that she had a special talent. In 1995, aged 14, Serena became a professional tennis player, and she won her first Grand Slam in 2002.

2 _____ During her career, she has won an incredible number of Grand Slams in singles, and women's and mixed doubles. She has also held all four major singles titles in the same year. In women's doubles, she has always played with her sister, Venus, and they have never lost a final together! Serena works hard off-court too. She has written her autobiography, and she has created her own line of sports clothes. She has also appeared in lots of TV shows and became the first black sportswoman to have a photo on the cover of *Vogue* magazine.

3 _____ But it hasn't always been easy for Serena. She has received lots of criticism from the media. Journalists have often chosen to focus on her physical appearance and her aggression on court, instead of her incredible achievements. However, Serena has never given up. She believes these obstacles have simply made her stronger.

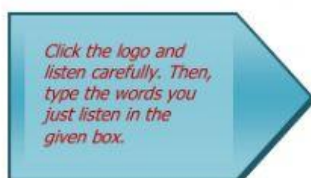
