

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

REMEMBER

To BE (PRESENT) am, is, are/am not, isn't, aren't		Main Verb (-ing)
+	I am having lunch now.	She is having lunch now. / You are having lunch now.
-	I'm not having lunch now.	She isn't having lunch now. / We aren't having lunch now.
?	Am I having lunch now?	Is Mary having lunch now? / Are they having lunch now?

SPELLING RULES	Most verbs add – ing: go ->going / watch -> watching ...
	Short verbs that ends with consonant+vowel+consonant, double the last consonant: swim -> swimming / sit -> sitting / run -> running ...
	Verbs ending in – e, cut – e and add – ing: live -> living / have -> having ...
	Verbs ending in – ie, the – ie changes to – y: lie -> lying ...

We use the Present Continuous for something happening at the moment of speaking. We also use it for something happening around now but maybe now at the moment of speaking.

 DON'T FORGET the TIME EXPRESSIONS: **now, right now, at the moment, at this moment, today, tonight, this week/month, semester..., these days.**
