Listening Strategy: Different Types of Talks

There are different types of talks, if you understand the type of talk, it will help you to predict answer using your knowledge of the topic. These are the most common types of talk.

1. Public Announcements.

These talks are messages given to the general public in specific locations like airports, airplanes, trains, buses and large events like conferences or sport games. The questions are usually focus on details about times and schedules, as well actions the listener needs to take.

2. Business talks.

These talks take place in business settings such as in meetings or in an office and can be things like announcements made to the staff. The questions generally focus on details like locations, people, and specific information.

3. Commercial messages

These will be talks similar to advertisements or commercial from television or the radio. The questions will focus on details of the product like specific features and prices. The questions could also ask about who might buy the product.

4. Recorded messages

These talks are similar to what you might hear when you call a business. The questions will usually focus on details of the message.

5. News, weather, and public service messages.

These talks will be like the news reports you would see on television or hear on the radio. The questions will vary likely focus on details about what the reporter has said.

Look at the following example.

Woman: Reports are in today of trouble on Wall Street. For three consecutive quarters, Doyle Industries has posted a loss. The company admitted to cash flow problems last month when hundreds of its employees did not get paid. Several company vehicles were also repossessed around the same time. The company has since fixed its payroll issues, but insiders believe that the electronics manufacturer will close at least one of its East Coast plants. Clues

- **Introduction:** The speaker refers to reports. A news program gives reports.
- **Body:** The woman gives detailed information about a company. This suggests we are listening to the business section of a news program.
- **Conclusion:** The woman tells us to check a website and watch a six o'clock show. News programs are frequently shown in the evenings.

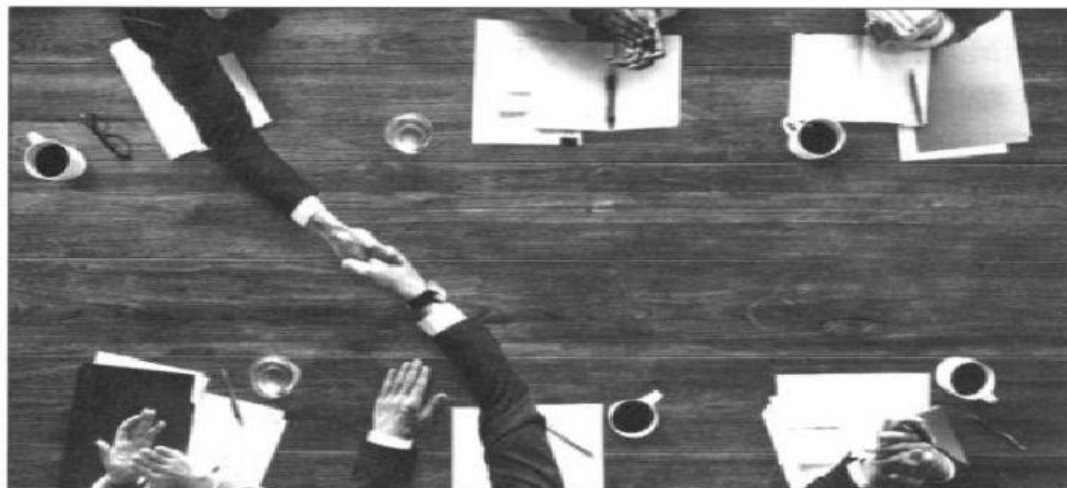
