Leonardo da Vinci was born in Vinci, Italy, in 1452. He was interested in science and nature.

1 When he was 14, his teacher was Verrocchio, an artist. Leonardo worked with him for six years and he learned different techniques. He worked with metal, leather and carving. He also drew, painted and sculpted.

2 Lorenzo de Medici, an important and influential man in those times, asked Leonardo to create a piece of art for the Duke of Monaco. After this first piece, the court asked him to create different pieces from 1482 to 1499. During these years, he created many pieces. Some of these are famous, but the most famous one is *The Last Supper*, a painting on one of the walls in the dining room of the monastery of Santa Maria delle Grazie in Milan, Italy. Over 1,000 people visit it every day.

3 Between 1505 and 1507, Leonardo created the most famous piece of artwork in the world: *The Mona Lisa*, a 77 cm by 53 cm painting. There are many theories and stories behind the *Mona Lisa*. Some think she was sick, others think it was a pregnant woman, others think it was a man. To this day, there is no evidence to prove any of these theories. At present, the famous painting is at the Louvre Museum in Paris.

4 Leonardo's talents exceeded the world of arts. He was also an inventor, a creator and a careful observer of nature. He drew a design for flying machines – the origin of the helicopter – and he made also extremely detailed drawings of the human body. He was particularly interested in the heart, and his description of how the arterial valves close and open, over 500 years ago, is true and valid today.
