Phrasal verbs

No object

Things hardly ever **work out** the first time.
You need to **stand out**.
Don't **give up** when it gets tough.

With object, separable

They **set up** a company.
(They **set it up**.)
I **figured out** the answer.
(I **figured it out**.)
Keep up the hard work.
(**Keep it up**.)
Give up candy and you'll feel better. (**Give it up**.)

With object, inseparable

Get over the problem. (**Get over it**.)
Work at something you're good at. (**Work at it**.)
