The festival lasts from the 8th to the 11th, with the main ceremonies on the 10th. A procession is held, starting at the foot of the sacred mountain and stopping at every small temple on the way up to the High Temple. Thousands of pilgrims gather in this venue to say their prayers and offer incense to the national ancestors. Besides the solemn ceremonies, various traditional fairs and contests are held with games like singing, wrestling, or swimming.
