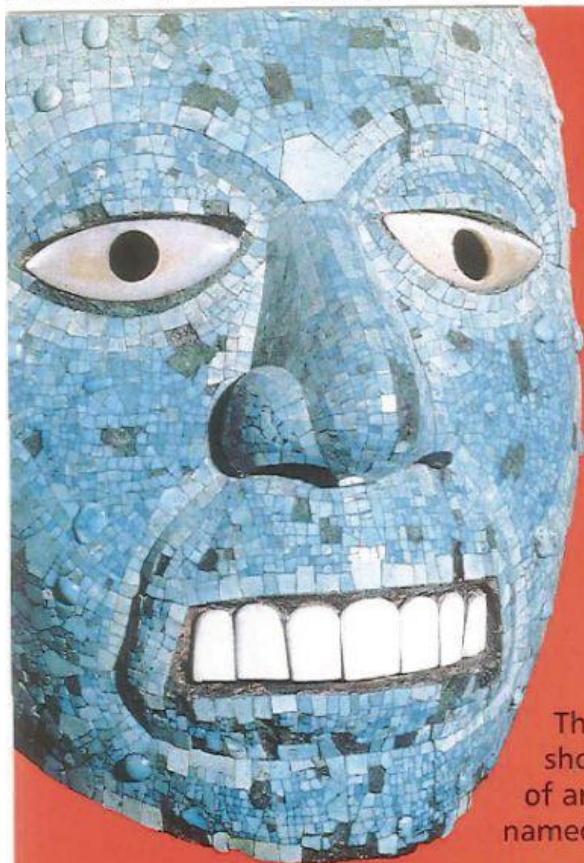

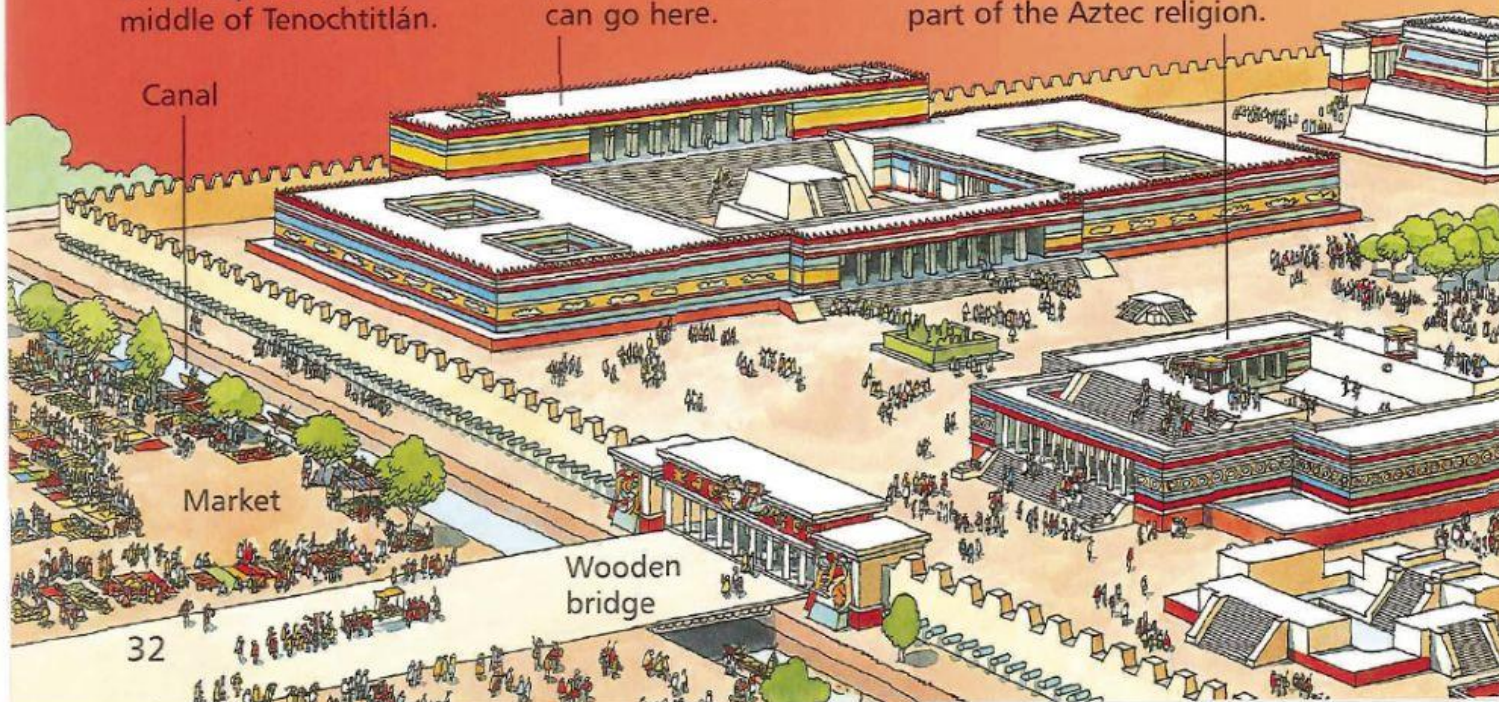
Island city

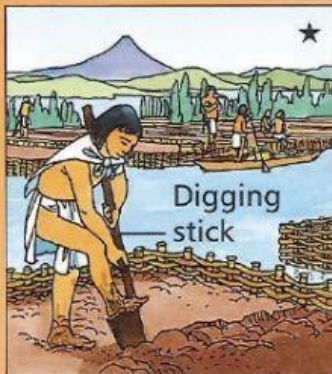
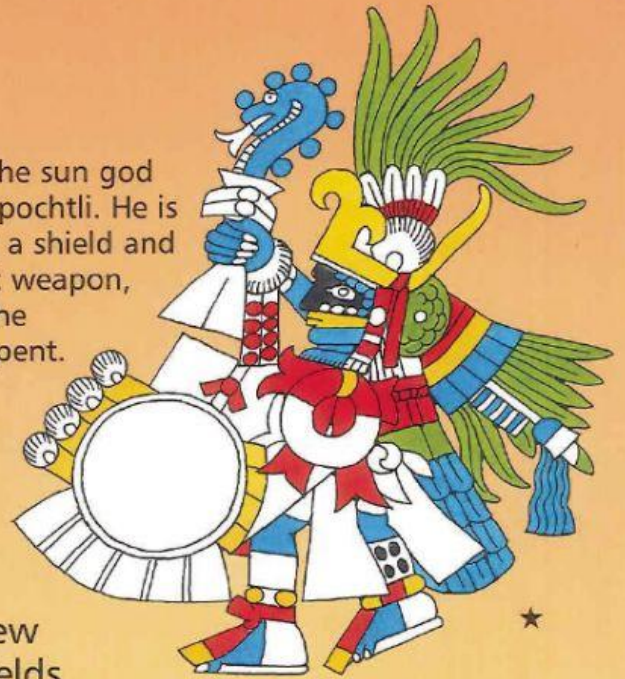

Gifts for a god

The Aztecs believed that their sun god needed human hearts to keep him alive. Every year, Aztec priests killed thousands of people and gave their hearts to the god. Most of the people who died like this were enemies who were captured in war.

This is the sun god Huitzilopochtli. He is holding a shield and a magic weapon, called the Fire Serpent.

Floating fields

In the lake all around Tenochtitlán, farmers grew food in huge, floating fields. The fields were like giant baskets filled with mud and soil. People grew corn, beans, tomatoes and peppers. They used the corn to bake thin pancakes, called tortillas.

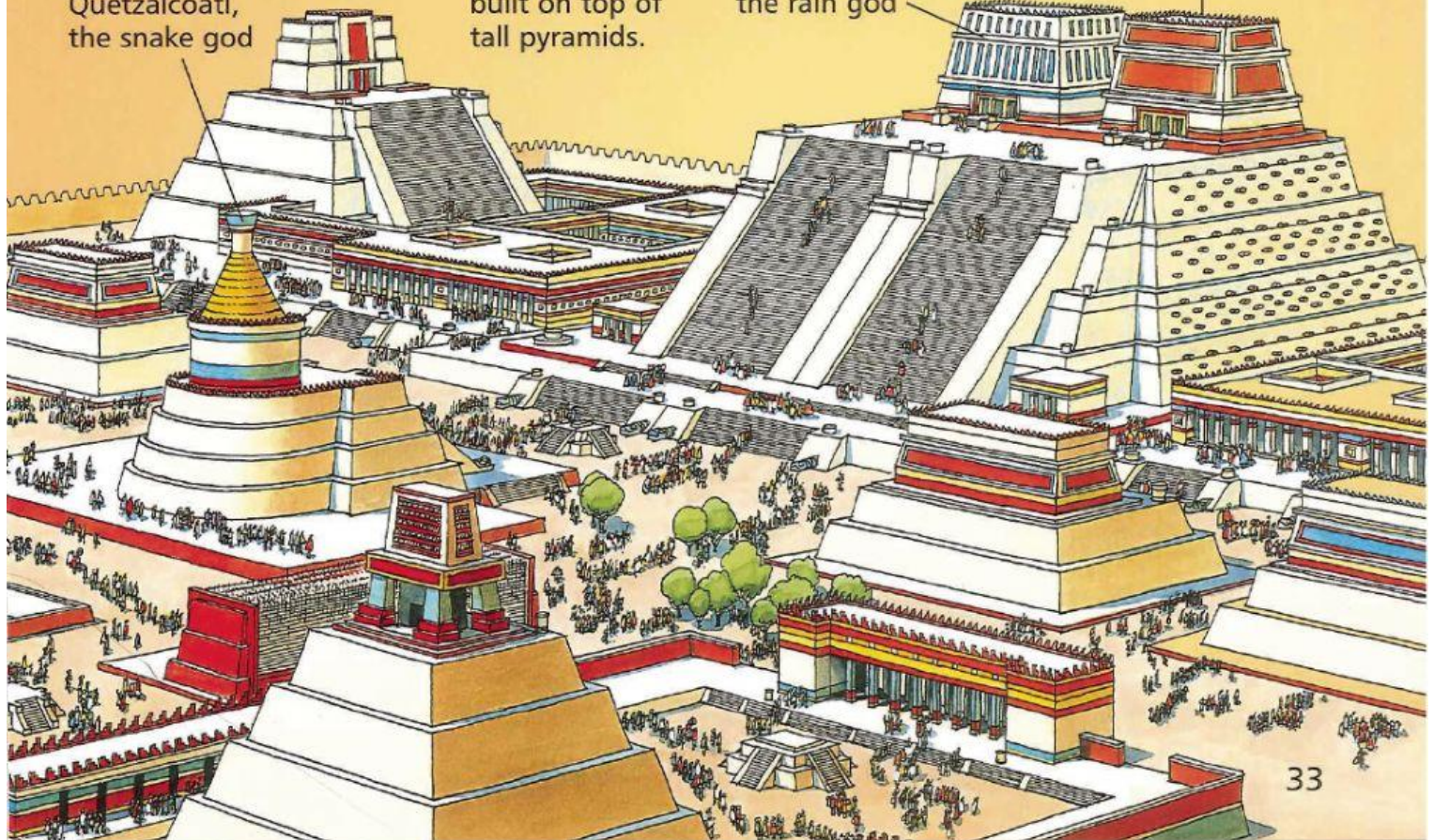
