


# /ð/ feather

1 First say /θ/

 Now listen to /ð/

Look at the mouth picture.

 Listen to /θ/ and /ð/ repeat.



Put your fingers on your throat.

Say /θ/. What can you feel?

You do not need your voice to say /θ/.

Say /ð/. What can you feel?

You need your voice to say /ð/.

/θ/ is **unvoiced**.

/ð/ is **voiced**.
