The Beatles were the most famous rock group in the sixties. Their golden years started in 1964, when many of their songs were heard all over the world. In that year, the group visited America, Asia and Australia. Wherever they went, they brought joy, love and happiness.

The Beatles' success came from the talent of *John Lennon*, the group leader. John was born in Liverpool, England, on October 9, 1940.

In 1958, John met *Paul McCartney* and formed a group. *George Harrison* joined them later. They played music in a small Liverpool club before *Ringo Starr* came in early 1962.

In the same year, they appeared on TV. And their first hit record "Love Me Do" sold 100,000 copies. A year later, "She Loves You" sold over a million. Their first movie "A Hard Day's Night" was in August 1964. At the end of that year, John's book called "In His Own Write" was a best-seller.


In 1969, John Lennon married *Yoko Ono*. The Beatles broke up in a year later, 1970. John's last album, "Double Fantasy", came out in November 1980. Three weeks after that, on the cold winter night of December 8, John Lennon was shot to death in front of his New York apartment.
