

SIMPLE FUTURE TENSE

The simple future tense uses **will** + **the simple form of the verb**. It is used to express:

A prediction based on an opinion	I think the Maple Leafs won't win the game.
A rapid decision	I'm thirsty. I think I will buy a drink.
An offer	That looks heavy. I will help you with it.
A promise	Don't worry, I won't tell anyone.
A threat	If you don't stop, I will tell your mother.
A refusal	She won't listen to anything I say.
Yes/No Question	Will it rain tomorrow? Won't they meet us at the restaurant at 5 pm?
Information Question	What will you do on Sunday? Why won't you come with us?

I	I
You	You
He	He
She will cook .	She won't cook .
It	It
We	We
They	They
I	Yes, I will . No, I won't .
you	Yes, you will . No, you won't .
he	Yes, he will . No, he won't .
Will/ Won't	she will ? it we they
	Yes, she will . No, she won't . Yes, it will . No, it won't . Yes, we will . No, we won't . Yes, they will . No, they won't .

Won't = will not

I'll = I will

You'll = You will

He'll = He will

She'll = She will

It'll = It will

We'll = We will

They'll = They will

Note: don't use a contraction with 'will' in a short answer.

Example:

- ✓ Yes, I will.
- ✗ Yes, I'll.
