Longshan Temple is one of the largest and oldest temples in Taiwan. Kuan-in (觀音) is the main god of the temple. You can wish for good luck here. 



History

It was built in 1738 by settlers (移民) from China. In 1919, it was rebuilt and finished in 1924.



Decoration

The beautiful temple is decorated with (裝飾) stone and wood. The dragons are made of bronze (青銅).
