1. How to Make Meatballs



Ingredients

- 1 kilo of very fine minced meat (preferably beef)
- 2 eggs
- 300 grams of tapioca-flour
- 4-8 cloves of garlic
- 1 red onion
- 1 teaspoon of white pepper
- 2 teaspoons of salt

Steps (fix it to the right sequence)

- 1) Then, boil some water in a rather large pot, at least about 2 liters.
- 2) Finally, lower the meatballs into the boiling water. When they float up to the surface the meatball are ready to serve.
- 3) First of all, mix garlic, red onion, salt, and white pepper in a mortar or mixer.
- 4) After that, use your fingers, add a cup of water, and keep on working until the mixture feels soft and smooth.
- 5) Second step, mix the spice-mixture with the eggs, the tapioca-flour and the minced meat.
- 6) Next step, start rolling the mixture into small meatballs.

2. How To Clean White Leather Shoes



Materials:

- Paper Towel
- Soap
- Old t-shirt or cotton rags
- Magic eraser

Steps **(fix it to the right sequence)**

- 1) Clean the sole: Wet the magic eraser and squeeze it to excess water. Rub the magic eraser up and down the soles of your shoes until the stains and dirt are gone. Make sure the magic eraser is damp, not dripping all over the shoes.
- 2) Remove dirt on the surface: Wet a paper towel. After that, squeeze the towel to excess water. Gently wipe down your shoes. This step will help remove big pieces of dirt. After you're done, let the shoes dry for 10 – 15 minutes.
- 3) Scrub with soap: Last step, wet your old t-shirt or cotton rags and lather it with some soap. Massage the upper part of the shoes with a small gentle motion. Make sure to massage until it returns to its white color. Then, wipe away any excess with the rag or t-shirt. After this, let your shoes dry for 10 – 15 minutes.

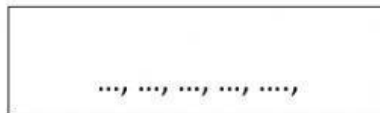
3. How to Use Chopsticks
