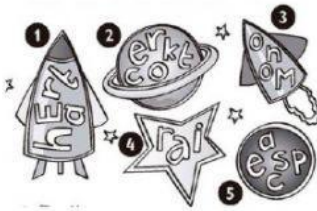

Three years later in 1961 the Russian, Yuri Gagarin, became the first person to orbit Earth in a spaceship. It wasn't until July 1969 that the American astronaut, Neil Armstrong, became the first person to walk on the Moon.
