Present perfect:
How long, for & since

We use the present perfect with *for* and *since* to talk about activities or situations that started in the past and are continuing in the present.

We've known each other for 8 years.

I haven't seen Carmel for two months.

We've been friends since 2008.

Eric hasn't played tennis since September.

We use *How long* to ask questions.

How long have you known your best friend?

Louis has been to China.

We use *gone* to say that a person is at a place but hasn't come back.
Lucia has gone to the swimming pool.
