Battle of Surabaya

The Battle of Surabaya was (1) _____ between pro-independence Indonesian soldiers and militia against British and British Indian troops as a part of the Indonesian National (2) _____.

Fighting broke out on 30 October after the British commander, Brigadier A. W. S. Mallaby was (5) _____ in a skirmish. The battle and defense mounted by the Indonesians galvanized the nation in support of independence and helped garner international attention. It also had the effect of convincing Britain that wisdom lay on the side of (9) _____ in the revolution; within a few years, in fact, Britain would support the Republican cause in the United Nations.
