Ingredient

- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup margarine
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup brown sugar
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup white sugar
- 1 egg
- $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp vanilla extract
- 1 cup plus 2 tbsp flour
- $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp salt
- $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp baking soda
- 1 pkg mini chocolate chips



Steps:

Mix margarine, sugar, and brown sugar. Add egg and vanilla. Add baking soda, salt, and then flour. Dump the chocolate chips on the mixture. Mix. Bake at 350° for 10 – 12 minutes.
