Read the information. Then read the task card. Match the notes a student has made about the novelist David Mitchell with the points from the card.

In IELTS Speaking Part 2, you will be given one minute to make notes.

Try to keep your notes short by not writing too much. It is a good idea to write two or three ideas for each point that appears on the task card, as this will ensure that you have enough to talk about.

Organising your points in the same order as they appear on the task card will help you to locate them easily during your talk.

what you know about the life of the person

what kind of creative work this person does / did

why you like this person's work

and describe the way this person's work makes you feel.
