FOCUS ON: Living in Britain

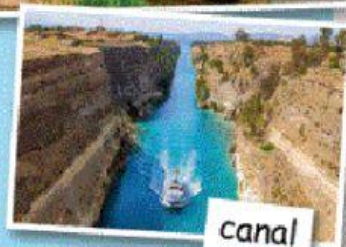


My name is Brian. I live on a houseboat in England. It's great. I can drive it on the canal. It has one bedroom, a living room, and a bathroom. I really love my home.

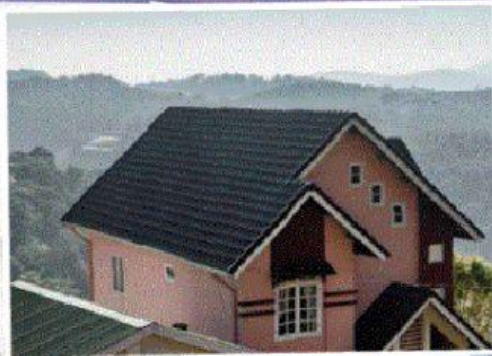
