

SIMPLE PRESENT OR SIMPLE FUTURE

① **SIMPLE PRESENT:** Used for:

- **Repeat actions.**

Ex: Mr. Dean **gets up** at 6 o'clock every morning.

- **Feelings, opinions, or thought**

Ex: I **feel** hungry. / I **'m** happy.

She **doesn't like** rock music.

I **think** he **is** hungry.

- **Facts and things that are true for a long time.**

Ex: The moon **goes** around the earth $27\frac{1}{2}$ days.

He **comes** from Viet Nam.

She never **eats** meat.

➔ **Signal words:** *always, usually, often, sometimes, hardly ever, rarely/ seldom, never, every (day/ week/ month/ year...)*

② **SIMPLE FUTURE:** Used for:

- **Facts in the future.**

Ex: I **will be** twelve next year.

- **Instant decision.**

Ex: We **will go** to the supermarket tomorrow.

- **Offers and promises.**

Ex: **Will** I **carry** your suitcase for you?

He promises he **won't go** to school late.

- **Predictions.**

Ex: I think he **will win** the race.

One day people **will travel** to the moon.

➔ **Signal words:** *tomorrow, soon, next (Saturday, week, month, year...), in (minute/ year in the future), I think/ hope/ guess/ believe/ promise, I am (not) sure*

! Notes:

- We usually use 'simple present and simple future' for the first conditional.

If + subject + simple present, subject + simple future

Ex: If it **is** cold, we **won't go** out.

Teacher **will be** angry if you **are** late for school.

We **won't finish** the report if we **don't** hurry.

- We usually use 'the simple present' after **when, before, after, until** and **as soon as**.

The other clause, we use 'the simple future'

S + simple future + when/ before/ after/ until/ as soon as + S + simple present

Ex: We **will stay** in the old house **until** we **find** a better one.

I **ll give** her your letter **when** I **see** her.
