### Form

### Use

When to use which tense?

1. For actions happening regularly, often or never, we use  
Simple present                      Present progressive
2. For actions happening now, we use  
Simple present                      Present progressive
3. The verbs 'be', 'have', 'like' and 'want' are normally only used in  
Simple present                      Present progressive
4. The signal word 'usually' indicates that we have to use  
Simple present                      Present progressive
5. The signal word 'now' indicates that we have to use  
Simple present                      Present progressive
