fat - fate	mad - made
gap - gape	cap - cape

The letter **a** says /æ/, if you see a consonant after it, but the letter **L** changes the letter **a** sound. We read **al** as /ɔ:l/



all ball tall also almost salt bald

And in these three words the letter **L** is silent. We read **al** as /ɔ:/ chalk talk walk

3 Read the texts
