

1. T or F 5 pounds of tomatoes cost \$15.50. How much does one pound of tomatoes cost? **The answer is \$20.50 because you add \$15.50 + 5.**

2. T or F A carton of eggs costs \$2.90 and a package of bacon costs \$3.10. How much does it cost to buy 2 cartons of eggs and 1 package of bacon? **The answer is \$2.90 + \$2.90 + \$3.10 = \$8.90.**

3. T or F Two boxes of cereal costs \$7.40 and buying one box of cereal only costs \$4. How much do you save by buying two boxes at the same time rather than one at a time? **The answer is 60 cents is how much you will save.**

$$\text{\$4.00} + \text{\$4.00} = \text{\$8.00}$$

$$\text{\$8.00} - \text{\$7.40} = \text{\$.60}$$

4. T or F A bottle of orange juice costs \$3.50 and a bottle of grape juice costs \$5.30. What is the difference in the price between the orange juice and the grape juice? **The answer is 8 dollars and 80 cents.**

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{\$3.50} \\ + \text{\$5.30} \\ \hline \text{\$8.80} \end{array}$$

5. T or F A jar of honey is \$2.40. How much do 4 jars of honey cost? **The answer is \$9.60.**

$$\text{\$2.40} \times 4 = \text{\$9.60}$$

$$\text{\$2.40} + \text{\$2.40} + \text{\$2.40} + \text{\$2.40} = \text{\$9.60}$$
