Thomas Edison

Thomas Edison was born in Ohio in 1847. He had hearing problems, most likely caused by a sickness called scarlet fever. He went to school for a short time. His mother ended up teaching him at home. As a teenager, he saved a boy from being hit by a train. The boy's father was very thankful. He taught Thomas railroad telegraphy as a reward. This helped Thomas get a job as a telegraph operator later that year. Edison invented many things. One great invention was the phonograph in 1877. It was the first machine that could record and make sound. He quickly became famous. Thomas Edison is best known for his work with the electric light. Others had worked on this before him. Edison made it possible to have electric light in homes.
