ELEPHANT ORPHANAGE

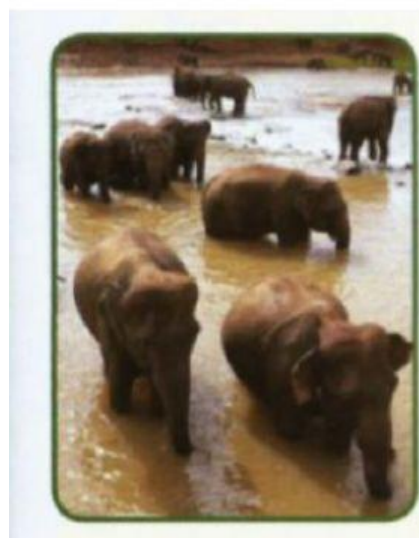
