AFFIRMATIVE

- ✓ THERE IS=THERE'S **A** **CINEMA** — Singular:
Hay un CINE
- ✓ THERE ARE=THERE'RE **THREE** **SHOPS** — Plural:
Hay tres TIENDAS

PREPOSITIONS

NEXT TO	Al lado de
OPPOSITE	En frente de
IN FRONT OF	Delante de
NEAR	Cerca

NEGATIVE

- ✗ THERE → ISN'T = IS NOT → **A** → **LIBRARY** — Singular:
No hay una BIBLIOTECA
- ✗ THERE → AREN'T = ARE NOT → **ANY** → **SHOPS** — Plural:
No hay ninguna TIENDA

INTERROGATIVE

SHORT ANSWERS

- IS → THERE → **A** **CINEMA?** → YES, THERE IS ✓ Singular:
¿Hay UN CINE? Sí hay/No, no hay.
- ARE → THERE → **ANY** **SHOPS?** → YES, THERE ARE ✓ Plural:
¿Hay TIENDAS? Sí, las hay/ No, no las hay.
- IS → THERE → **A** **CINEMA?** → NO, THERE ISN'T ✗
- ARE → THERE → **ANY** **SHOPS?** → NO, THERE AREN'T ✗
