

**The Globe Theatre (THE UK) (prepositions, articles, wordformation)

The / A / An / - Globe Theatre is situated **on / in / of /** - the banks of **the / a / an /** - River Thames, about 200 metres from the original site of Shakespeare's 1599 (**BUILD**). It's a faithful reconstruction of the open-air playhouse where Shakespeare worked, and for which he wrote many of his greatest plays. Due **in / to / at / of** the fact that the theatre is open to **the / a / an /** - sky, the season is limited **by / to / for / of** only six months of the year, running from April to October. The theatre itself is circular in shape and the seated areas are in the lower, middle, and upper galleries. In (**ADD**) to the seated galleries, there is an area **on / in / of /** - front of the stage called the Yard, where (**VISIT**) can stand and watch the play. Before attending a (**PERFORM**), (**VISIT**) need to bear a certain thing in **the / a / an /** - mind. As it is a 16th century replica, the theatre doesn't boast any **by / to / for / of** the comforts of modern-day life and (**PERFORM**) continue whatever **the / a / an /** - weather.
