## COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVES

Los comparative adjectives se utilizan para comparar una determinada característica o cualidad entre dos o más cosas, animales o personas.



### ELEPHANT

Lifespan: 60-70 years  
Age: 37 years old  
Weight: 7,000 kg  
Length: 7,5 metres



### CROCODILE

Lifespan: 80-100 years  
Age: 10 years old  
Weight: 500 kg  
Length: 6,2 metres



### LION

Lifespan: 25-30 years  
Age: 18 years old  
Weight: 250 kg  
Length: 2 metres

The lion is **older** than the crocodile, but the elephant is **the oldest**.

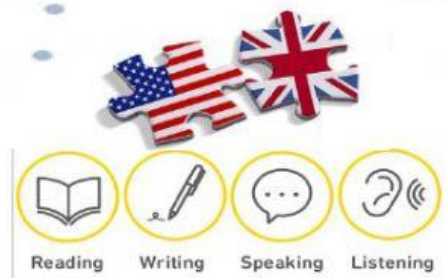
