<b>Demonstrative Pronoun</b>	<b>This</b> is Sam's dog. <b>That</b> is Amy's cat. I like <b>this</b> . I want <b>that</b> .	<b>These</b> are my pictures. <b>Those</b> are John's books. I like <b>these</b> . I want <b>those</b> .
<b>Demonstrative Adjective</b>	<b>This</b> dog is smart. <b>That</b> cat is cute.	<b>These</b> pictures are great. <b>Those</b> books are difficult.
